Severe liver problems, which in rare cases can lead to death. 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
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

### "DEATH CHECKS IN" BY DAVID S. PEDERSON c.2018, Bold Strokes Books | \$18.95 | 235 pages



### A nice little getaway.

That's all you wanted: two days alone, just you and your amour, with nothing to do but follow your whims. It would be perfect, idyllic – until it wasn't, and Responsible You won out over Romantic You. As in the new novel "Death Checks In" by David S. Pederson, it's back to work.

Detective Heath Barrington had it all planned out: he and his boyfriend, Officer Alan Keyes would take the train from Milwaukee to Chicago, grab a cab to the downtown area, check into the Edmonton Hotel, and enjoy a wonderful

It was 1947 and being gay could get a man in trouble, but Heath knew there'd be more anonymity for him and Alan in a larger city. The weather would be perfect for exploring nightclubs and sightseeing; there was plenty of entertainment nearby and a live show with a band inside the Edmonton. That, of course, meant that Alan would need a tuxedo so Heath offered to purchase one for him – which was when the men met Victor Blount, haberdasher.

Blount was a small man with a French accent and a dramatic way about him. He said he was an expert tailor, that he dabbled in photography, and that he could secure "discreet" entertainment for Alan and Heath. That was odd, but Blount wasn't the only character at the Edmonton: the hotel's assistant manager was a blustery guy who had his eye on one of the regular guests, a "full-figured," flirty widow from New York. A dotty old lady from nearby came to the Edmonton often enough for waitstaff to know her preferences. And the one-eyed piano player and his songstress-wife left an impression on Heath by arguing loudly with Blount, who seemed to be overcharging them.

Two days. That's plenty of time for a romantic rendezvous, had Heath left work alone. But when Blount was found dead in his back room with "W" scrawled on the floor in his blood and a spool of green thread in his hand, two days was also long enough to solve a crime...

Strictly looking at "Death Checks In" as a mystery, it's not bad. That it's a noir whodunit is nice, the main characters are familiar from past books, it has that old-black-and-white-movie feel you know you love, and it's sweetly chaste, in a late-1940s way.

Charming, in other words.

But tedious also describes this novel just as equally since a lot of its action comes through dialog, of which there too much and in too much fussy, stiff detail. It's wordy and it feels like filler. It doesn't help that author David S. Pederson added an eccentric old woman in this story, who constantly clucks like a chicken.

Yes, that's written into numerous sentences.

No, it's not fun.

Overall, if you can avoid doing that "speed it up" movement with your hand, or if you like noir mysteries that are more on the light side, only then will this book fit. For you, then, "Death Checks In" is a worthwhile getaway.




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# MYBIG GAY LIFE Brad Toekle



### A TALE OF TWO TURKEYS

Growing up we used to split Thanksgiving between my mother's family and my father's family. My father's family, the Loekle's, were the most peaceful, white family you've ever met. And not a fake peaceful white, like you see in The Virgin Suicides or Connecticut, but a genuinely happy, white as hell, family. My great grandmother, Lucy, was the supreme matriarch. She belonged to the Audubon Society and The Grange and served our meals on fine china and silver. This was always the first Thanksgiving of the day. Lucy, or Grammy as I knew her, was a perpetually ancient woman so Thanksgiving "dinner" was promptly at noon. The only time I ever remember there being anything but laughter and love at that dinner table was during the Great Sweet Potato Debate of 1989. Voices were raised in fervent debate as to whether the "candied yams" Grammy had been making for 50 years were, in fact, candied sweet potatoes. Her two sons weighed in with "interesting articles" they'd read in this naturalist magazine or another about this seasonal carbohydrate confusion. After a lively five minute conversation, Grammy firmly put her fork and knife down to say, "Listen, son, I'm not going to debate this anymore. If I say they are yams, they are yams. The end." And thus ended the Great Sweet Potato Debate of 1989 and the only fight I ever say at a Loekle family holiday.

Around five o'clock each, we'd then cross Bergen County, New Jersey to enter into the Pandora's box that was my mother's family gatherings. My mother, one of seven sisters, belonged to a very loud tribe. And Irish woman had married an Italian man and had then set out to give life to, and then subsequently destroy, seven little girls in a row. Holidays at the Rossi house often made Running with Scissors seem like a rom-com. The key was to arrive early enough to get the good party of the crazy before the bad part kicked in; because when it kicked in it kicked in full tilt boogie. There's was a giant dining table that sat all eight daughters, two parents, 4-6 aunts and uncles, and my other great grandmother: Noni. Noni was an ancient Italian woman with weather, warm hands who spoke broken English and used to sing dirty Italian songs that none of us understood but we knew were raunchy and delightful.

# MY BIG GAY LIFE

There were countless debates and degradations at a Rossi Thanksgiving. Boyfriends were kicked out by parents, parents threw glassware at other parents, old wounds were carved up and open like well dressed birds, and we all knew Thanksgiving was finished when my grandfather would storm into his bedroom and barricade the door with the dresser, so as not to let the women in his life that he hated so much get at him.

If The Great Sweet Potato Debate of 1989 was the greatest fight in my father's family home, then Philip Glass the Turkey was the greatest debacle in my Mother's family home. This was also in the late 1980's... what can I say, they were heady times? The tide had turned in the psych ward that was the Thanksgiving dining room on Rolling Ridge Road. I had taken my usual position of neutrality underneath the dining room table. From here I could listen to the family fray as if it were an old timey radio drama. Comeplete with the sound effects of glasses braking and doors being slammed. A physical struggle had begun over the turkey between my grand parents. I can't recall why, but I'm sure it was insane. Behind their seats at the head of the table, sat a bay window that looks out on the steep rolling hill of a back yard. Suddenly the sound of one scream followed by what sounded like a car wreck. Not an entirely inappropriate sound effect for any Rossi family gathering. Our poor, half eaten turkey had fled the scene of the crime straight through the bay window and down the rolling hill.

Later that evening, when some of my aunts snuck me out into the back yard with them to get away from the drama, we sat cross-legged around the turkey with a small wireless radio playing the Rolling Stones "She's So Cold". And as my aunts lit up a joint, we began to laugh about the day's events, our insane family, and this poor turkey who had thought his pain was over once he was slaughtered and cooked. Only to find there was still a war for this undead soldier to fight. We named him Philip Glass the Turkey and buried him under the autumn leaves to rest in peace.

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
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## **ASK NANA**
