If you've ever wondered what it feels like to live inside a sun drenched beach scene filled with drag queens, mango trees, and women who can fix your sink and your life, welcome to Key West in May. The island is starting to relax again after high season, shaking off the last of the winter crowds, and settling into that sweet spot where locals reclaim their favorite bar stools and visitors who arrive now are savvy enough to know they've hit the jackpot.

And for lesbians? May is basically our unofficial holiday season. No one declared it, but trust me — the island did.

Let's start with the obvious: Key West has always been gay and always will be. It's not a trend. It's not a marketing campaign. It's not a rainbow washed seasonal special - though we avidly support our rainbows. It's the DNA of the island. The Conch Republic was queer before queer was cool, and the women here have been quietly (and not so quietly) holding it down for decades — running businesses, running households, running the local government, running the show. Our community isn't just strong; it's the backbone of the island's culture, creativity, and resilience.

And in May, that strength shows up everywhere.

Take Songwriters Festival, for example. While the bros in cargo shorts are busy arguing about which Nashville guy wrote which country hit, the lesbians are already three steps ahead — perched at the back of the bar, sunglasses on, iced drink in hand, scouting for the queer women with guitars. You can spot us by the way we nod appreciatively at a well crafted lyric or the way we whisper, "She definitely dates women," with the confidence of a seasoned wildlife tracker.

Then there's Mother's Day weekend, which in Key West is less about brunch with your biological mother and more about celebrating the many women who

raised you — your chosen family, your bar family, your softball team family, your “we met at Womenfest in 2014 and never stopped texting” family. On this island, motherhood is expansive, communal, and often accompanied by mimosas.

May also brings the kind of weather that makes lesbians nationwide consider relocating. The humidity hasn’t reached its full “I’m here to ruin your hair and your attitude” potential yet, and the water is warm enough for paddleboarding, kayaking, and the classic lesbian sport of “accidentally” running into your crush at Higgs Beach. If you’ve never locked eyes with a woman across a shoreline while both of you pretend you’re not checking each other out, you haven’t lived.

And let’s not forget the locals’ favorite May pastime: complaining about the heat while simultaneously bragging about how much we love it here. It’s a delicate balance. You’ll hear things like, “It’s hot as hell,” immediately followed by, “But honestly, I could never live anywhere else.” That’s the Key West way — a little dramatic, a little proud, and always delivered with a wink.

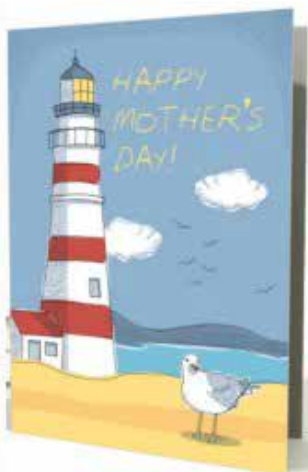
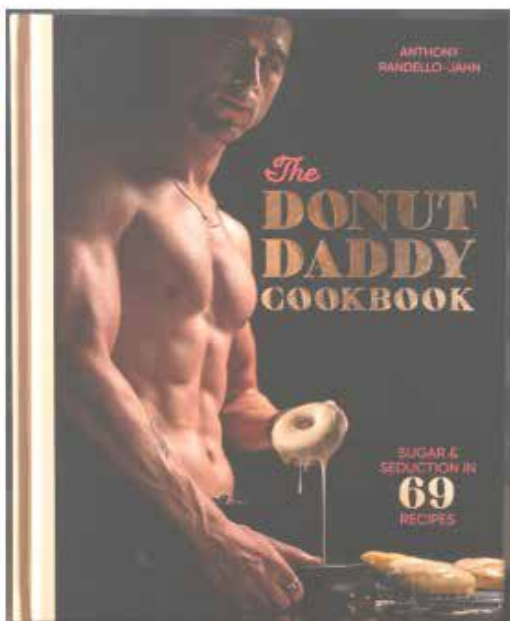
Through it all, the island’s motto — One Human Family — isn’t just a slogan we slap on bumper stickers. It’s the truth of how we live. It’s the reason queer women feel safe holding hands on Duval. It’s why newcomers are welcomed like long lost cousins. It’s why our community shows up for each other, whether it’s a fundraiser, a potluck, or someone simply needing a ride home after realizing tequila was a mistake.

May in Key West is a reminder that queer joy isn’t seasonal here. It’s not reserved for Pride or Womenfest or any particular weekend. It’s woven into the island’s rhythm — in the music drifting from open windows, in the laughter echoing down Petronia Street, in the quiet moments when you realize you’re exactly where you’re meant to be.

So if you’re a lesbian looking for a sign to visit Key West in May, consider this your official invitation. Come for the sunshine, stay for the community, and leave with the knowledge that this little island at the end of the road has been queer forever — and isn’t changing anytime soon.

After all, paradise is better when it’s shared. So Lez Go Out and do the nod at Songwriters, wink at the beach and own this island this May... See you at the bar.

Not just gay -GAY!



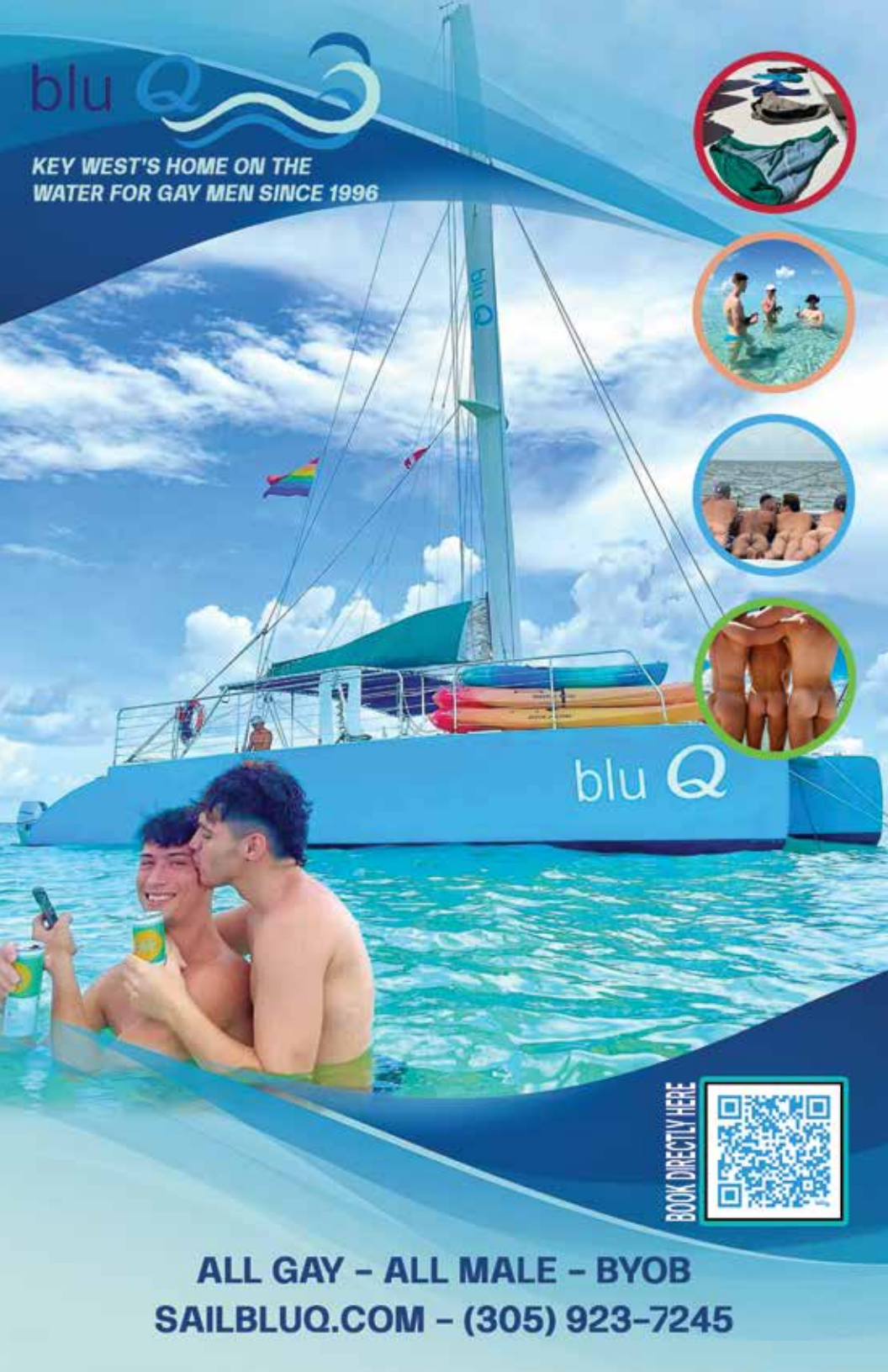

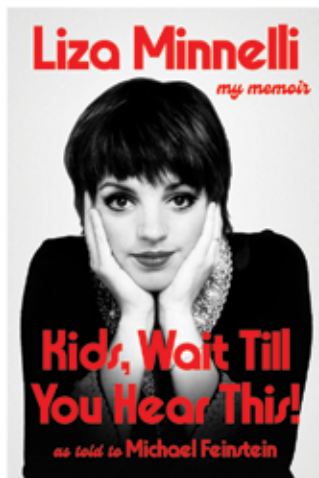

"KIDS, WAIT TILL YOU HEAR THIS! MY MEMOIR"

BY LIZA MINNELLI, AS TOLD TO MICHAEL FEINSTEIN

Twenty feet in front of you, and you can't see a thing.

Even the closest faces are in shadow – lit, but not quite enough for you to see for sure what the people there are thinking. Still, you can hear them, their gasps, their laughter, and applause. Such is life, on-stage. Now read “Kids, Wait Till You Hear This! My Memoir” by Liza Minnelli, as told to Michael Feinstein, and read about it beyond the spotlight.

Almost from the moment she was born, Liza Minnelli was famous.

It was inevitable: her mother was Judy Garland. Her father was director Vincente Minnelli. Her godparents were Hollywood glitterati, her neighbors were famous, her playmates would be famous someday, too.

But her life wasn't all starlight and happiness.

She made her stage debut as a toddler. She became her “mother's caretaker” at age 13.

At 16, she had a growing career of her own – one that her mother tried to stop. But, she says, “In her own way, Mama was wonderful to me. Try understanding – she was my mother, not a movie star.... I knew her as the person who loved me and always would.”

At 19, Minnelli was working, happy, and madly in love with the man who'd become her first husband, and life was wonderful - until she came home one day to find him in their bed with another man. Before they were divorced, she lost her beloved mother, and became "engaged" to two other men simultaneously, neither of which made it to the altar with her.

She married her second husband, the son of one of her mother's former co-stars, in 1974 but her love affairs and addictions led to a second divorce.

Her third husband was a stage manager.

She doesn't have much good to say about her fourth, and last, husband. Overall, she says, "You gotta play the comedy for all it's worth and leave 'em laughing. Even when your heart is breaking."

Are you expecting bluntness, sass, or attitude here? Good, because that's what you get inside "Kids, Wait Till You Hear This!" It's strong on honesty and don't-give-a-flip. It's wonderfully edited, so it moves fast. It's eye-opening and funny and a pleasant surprise for a first, and only (so far), memoir.

Even better, author Liza Minnelli (with best friend, Michael Feinstein) is really quite candid and nicely gossipy, starting from the beginning. There are some Hollywood folks, in fact, who are feeling edgy tonight, because of what's inside this book and the secrets spilled. Minnelli and Feinstein seemed to have fun telling her story, and they comfortably lure readers in.

That's not to say that it's all a cabaret. Minnelli tells about her addictions and recoveries, her marriages and why she wed two gay men, and the losses she endured, including miscarriages, deaths, and broken relationships. The bad balances well with the good for a tale that's several notches above most celebrity memoirs. "Kids, Wait Till You Hear This!" is, in fact, a real joy to read, a genuine bright spot.
