# LEZ GO OUT



Pride. My favorite definition of the word as found in the Oxford Dictionary is "Consciousness of one's own dignity." The idea that one is proud of themselves for what makes them who they are. Nothing about that is threatening or harmful to anyone, in any way. It is happiness. So, why does this word, this declaration of self-love incite so much hate and fear?

Pride started as a riot, a fight to simply exist and in 2025 the fight to be proud has reached a pinnacle of importance in the USA, as the political climate attempts to make the letters in our rainbow family cease to exist. They want to take their pride and make us hide again. So, this year it is essential that we be more proud and visible than ever before.

Our history is not widely taught. Even people in the LGBTQ community are lacking in education about our intense history and why Pride is actually important - hell, it's critical - so I'm going to hold a little class on why Pride is important here in Key West and in every single town around the world. Gather 'round all. It's story time.

Pride celebrations around the United States of America need us this year. They need us to show up in large numbers to show the world that we are still here and will not be stripped of our pride or right to exist. Pride is important because it fosters self-respect, identity, and community—especially for marginalized groups like us. For LGBTQ+ people, Pride is a celebration of visibility, dignity, and resistance against discrimination and oppression. It honors the struggles that led to greater rights and acceptance while promoting solidarity and ongoing advocacy for equality. Historically, Pride traces back to the Stonewall Riots of 1969 in New York City, a pivotal moment in the LGBTQ+ rights movement. After years of police raids and legal discrimination, the riots marked a shift toward open resistance and activism. In 1970, the first Pride marches were held to commemorate Stonewall, establishing Pride as both a celebration and a protest. Culturally, Pride events have grown into global expressions of LGBTQ+ identity, resilience, and unity. They challenge stigma by making queer lives visible and affirming. Pride also honors the diversity within the LGBTQ+ community—across races, genders, abilities, and more—and continues to push for rights where they're still denied and where they are being threatened or stripped away, even in 2025.

In the United States, Pride has played a crucial role in advancing LGBTQ+ rights and visibility, both socially and politically. Here are a few key examples:



### 1. Stonewall and the Birth of Pride (1969-1970)

After the police raid at the Stonewall Inn in NYC in June 1969, LGBTQ+ people fought back, sparking days of protest.

The following year, the first Pride marches were held in New York, Chicago, and Los Angeles, turning personal resistance into public activism.

These events helped transform a hidden, criminalized identity into a movement for civil rights.

### 2. AIDS Activism and Pride in the 1980s-1990s

During the AIDS crisis, Pride became a space for mourning, protest, and survival.

Groups like ACT UP used Pride events to demand government action and public awareness.

Pride helped destigmatize HIV/AIDS and mobilized a generation of LGBTQ+ activists.

### 3. Legal Milestones and Cultural Shifts

Pride has been a platform to rally around major political issues:

Repealing "Don't Ask, Don't Tell" (2010)

Striking down the Defense of Marriage Act (2013)

Legalizing same-sex marriage nationwide (Obergefell v. Hodges, 2015)

These wins were supported by decades of visibility, organizing, and cultural normalization that Pride helped foster.

### 4. Modern Pride as Intersectional and Diverse

In recent years, many Pride events in the U.S. have grown more inclusive of trans people, people of color, immigrants, and disabled LGBTQ+ individuals.

Movements like Black Lives Matter have intersected with Pride to highlight racial justice within queer communities.

Pride in the U.S. is not just a celebration—it's a living reflection of how LGBTQ+ rights have advanced through courage, protest, and unity, and a reminder of the work still ahead.

When I was 15 in the early 2000's, I went to my first PrideFest in my hometown filled with gays and lesbians openly holding hands, laughing with one another, elder gays wearing matching rings and haircuts and being freely openly gay with no fear of harassment. It was the very first time I saw people like me just existing in a public place. It was freeing. I was empowered to be myself and the feelings of uncertainty and fear of isolation melted away. I was proud, for the very first time, to be who I was conscious of being. A young lesbian.

Key West has long been an LGBTQ safe haven, where we are celebrated; a critical feature woven into the fabric of the community, making it a destination for ALL people. We throw the parties that people travel from across the world to attend. We make the colors, music, plays, architecture, entertainment, local government and community based philanthropy thrive here on this beautiful island at the southernmost tip of the United States. We are proud to be who we are and no administration today, or any time, in the future can erase us. Show up to your Pride Celebrations and remind them who we are! We're proud. We love boldly and openly what makes us who we are. Pride in Key West runs from June 22-29 with dozens of events all over the island that dazzle and delight. So Lez Go Out and be visible, loud, cause good trouble and show our Pride so loud that they desperately want to join our party, rather than fear it. See you in the parade. The Husbutch and I will be there to hold the flag with you, now and always. Proudly.



m H}$ appy is the bride the sun shines on.

Of all the cliches that exist about weddings, that's the one that seems to make you smile the most. Just invoking good weather and bright sunshine feels like a cosmic blessing on the newlyweds and their future. It's a happy omen for bride and groom or, as in the new book "When the Harvest Comes" by Denne Michele Norris, for groom and groom.

Davis Freeman never thought he could love or be loved like this.

He was wildly, wholeheartedly, mind-and-soul smitten with Everett Caldwell, and life was everything that Davis ever wanted. He was a successful symphony musician in New York. They had an apartment they enjoyed and friends they cherished. Now it was their wedding day, a day Davis had planned with the man he adored, the details almost down to the stitches in their attire. He'd even purchased a gorgeous wedding gown that he'd never risk wearing.

He knew that Everett's family loved him a lot, but Davis didn't dare tickle the fates with a white dress on their big day. Everett's dad, just like Davis's own father, had considerable reservations about his son marrying another man – although Everett's father seemed to have come to terms with his son's bisexuality. Davis's father, whom Davis called the Reverend, never would. Years ago, father and son had a falling-out that destroyed any chance of peace between Davis and his dad; in fact, the door slammed shut to any reconciliation.

But Davis tried not to think about that. Not on his wedding day. Not, unbeknownst to him, as the Reverend was rushing toward the wedding venue, uninvited but not unrepentant. Not when there was an accident and the Reverent was killed, miles away and during the nuptials.

Davis didn't know that, of course, as he was marrying the love of his life. Neither did Everett, who had familial problems of his own, including homophobic family members who tried (but failed) to pretend otherwise.

Happy is the groom the sun shines on. But when the storm comes, it can be impossible to remain sunny.

What can be said about "When the Harvest Comes"? It's a romance with a bit of ghost-pepper-like heat that's not there for the mere sake of titillation. It's filled with drama, intrigue, hate, characters you want to just slap, and some in bad need of a hug.

In short, this book is quite stunning.

Author Denne Michele Norris offers a love story that's everything you want in this genre, including partners you genuinely want to get to know, in situations that are real. This is done by putting readers inside the characters' minds, letting Davis and Everett themselves explain why they acted as they did, mistakes and all. Don't be surprised if you have to read the last few pages twice to best enjoy how things end. You won't be sorry.

If you want a complicated, boy-meets-boy, family-mess kind of book with occasional heat, "When the Harvest Comes" is your book. Truly, this novel shines.






