June has always felt like a homecoming for queer women — a month where the air itself seems to shimmer with possibility. Pride Month isn't just a celebration; it's a reminder of our resilience, our joy, and our right to take up space. For lesbians especially, Pride is a time to be seen in our fullness: our relationships, our friendships, our chosen families, our softness, our strength. It's a moment when the world pauses long enough for us to breathe deeply and say, Yes. This is who we are.

And if there's any place that understands the heart of Pride, it's Key West.

Key West Pride is legendary — not just because it's fun (and it is wildly fun), but because it's rooted in something real. The parades, the parties, the drag shows, the women's events, the late night laughter on Duval — all of it sits on top of a long history of radical welcome.

This island has been a safe haven for LGBTQ+ people for generations. Long before rainbow crosswalks and corporate Pride campaigns, Key West was already living its truth. Queer artists, writers, bartenders, sailors, misfits, and dreamers found refuge here, and the island embraced them without hesitation. It didn't just tolerate us — it celebrated us.

That legacy is why Pride here feels different. It's not a performance. It's a pulse.

Across the country, Pride events are being challenged, restricted, or targeted. Queer visibility is being politicized in ways that feel both familiar and exhausting. For many LGBTQ+ people — especially queer women and trans folks — simply gathering in public can feel like an act of courage.

This island has weathered storms, both literal and cultural, and still flies its rainbow flag high. Pride here isn't shrinking. It isn't apologizing. It isn't stepping back to make room for intolerance. If anything, the pressure from outside only strengthens the island's resolve to protect its LGBTQ+ community. This year Pride will happen filled with colorful events, street fairs, pool parties and unapologetic visibility and though next year may be a different version, I have every confidence that it will continue.

Key West sends a clear message: Pride is not negotiable.

One of the most beautiful examples of that spirit is the Rainbow Fence Project, created by our own Fence Fairy, Anne Brodsky. What started as a simple idea — painting fences in rainbow colors to resist the rainbow coverup by the state — has become a powerful symbol of solidarity, visibility, and loving resistance.

Anne's project isn't loud or confrontational. It's gentle, colorful, and deeply intentional. It transforms everyday spaces into declarations of unity. It invites neighbors to pick up a brush, share a conversation, and create something that says, "You are safe here. You belong."

In a time when queer visibility is being challenged, the Rainbow Fence Project is a reminder that resistance doesn't always look like shouting. Sometimes it looks like color. Sometimes it looks like community. Sometimes it looks like a fence that quietly, proudly refuses to blend in.

Key West doesn't just host Pride — it embodies it. The island's motto, One Human Family, isn't a marketing slogan. It's a lived philosophy. It's why queer couples walk hand in hand without fear. It's why chosen families flourish. It's why lesbians who visit for a weekend often find themselves returning again and again, drawn by the sense that this place sees them fully.

Pride here is woven into the island's DNA. It's in the rainbow crosswalks, the queer owned businesses, the drag queens who know your name, the women's nights that feel like home, the sunsets that remind you you're part of something bigger.

And it's in the people — people like Anne, people like the volunteers who show up year after year, people who paint fences, raise flags, march, dance, and love loudly.

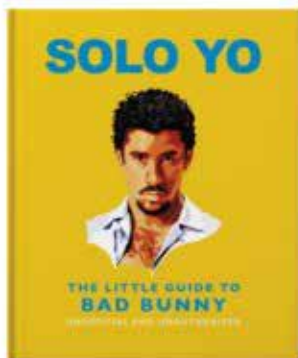
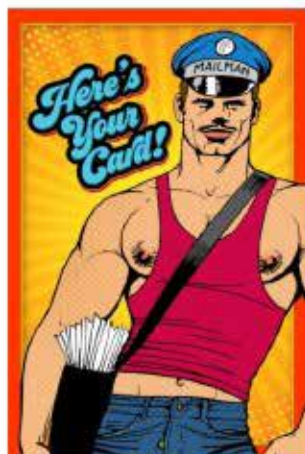

“HOW TO BE OKAY WHEN NOTHING IS OKAY” BY JENNY LAWSON

advice to help her keep her head and her heart on-track throughout her adult life. That random guidance has gotten her through a lot of days, and she shares it in this book.

First of all, remember that we're all weird in one way or another. You're not alone.

Forget people who rain on your parade; if there's something you enjoy doing and it's not hurting anyone, just do it, even if it's “childish.” Know that learning to love your flaws is something magical, and humorously admitting them can be truly priceless.

Keep a list of things that make you happy. Add to it, revise it, but keep it close; if you don't know where to start, look at Lawson's list for ideas.

So what are you gonna do next?

You can't decide. There are so many choices and you know you're going to pick the wrong one. That's the problem, you never do anything right and you don't know what to do next. So here: take a deep breath, take another, read “How to Be Okay When Nothing is Okay” by Jenny Lawson, and hit “reset.”

As someone who's always been open about her mental health issues, depression, ADHD and anxiety, Jenny Lawson has purposefully collected bits of advice to help her keep her head and her

Remember that everybody deserves applause, and that includes you.

Make a playlist of the music that makes you want to dance – and then dance. Keep in mind that “Depression lies” and that you are always and forever “worthwhile.” Give yourself permission to take solitary breaks now and then. If you’re feeling overwhelmed, do something that’s easy to accomplish. Teach others to help you by helping yourself. Revive your creativity by trying something new.

Never be afraid to ask for help, even if it’s just having someone listen awhile. Prioritize sleep. Explore using color noises to help you focus or chill.

And know that rules are often optional, so just be you.

We’ve all had them: a whole week’s worth of One of Those Days, where everything turns south and you just want to go to bed for life. You need a reset. That’s when you need “How to Be Okay When Nothing is Okay.”

From comfort and self-care to mood-boosts to confidence generators, author Jenny Lawson offers advice for anyone with any kind of mindset. Doubts are sent packing with this book. Self-flagellation can turn into a pat on the back here. And the theme, over and over, is that you’re not alone and that you can find help - which is underscored, even if you already know it to your core. Lawson hammers it home, along with all the right things to say, plus well-placed profanity, camaraderie, and plenty of her signature humor.

This book is the perfect size to tuck in your desk drawer, your lunchbox, briefcase, or glove box. It’s helpful, funny, and easily browse-able, so if your mental health isn’t so healthy today, find “How to Be Okay When Nothing is Okay.” Look over your TBR pile, and make it next.

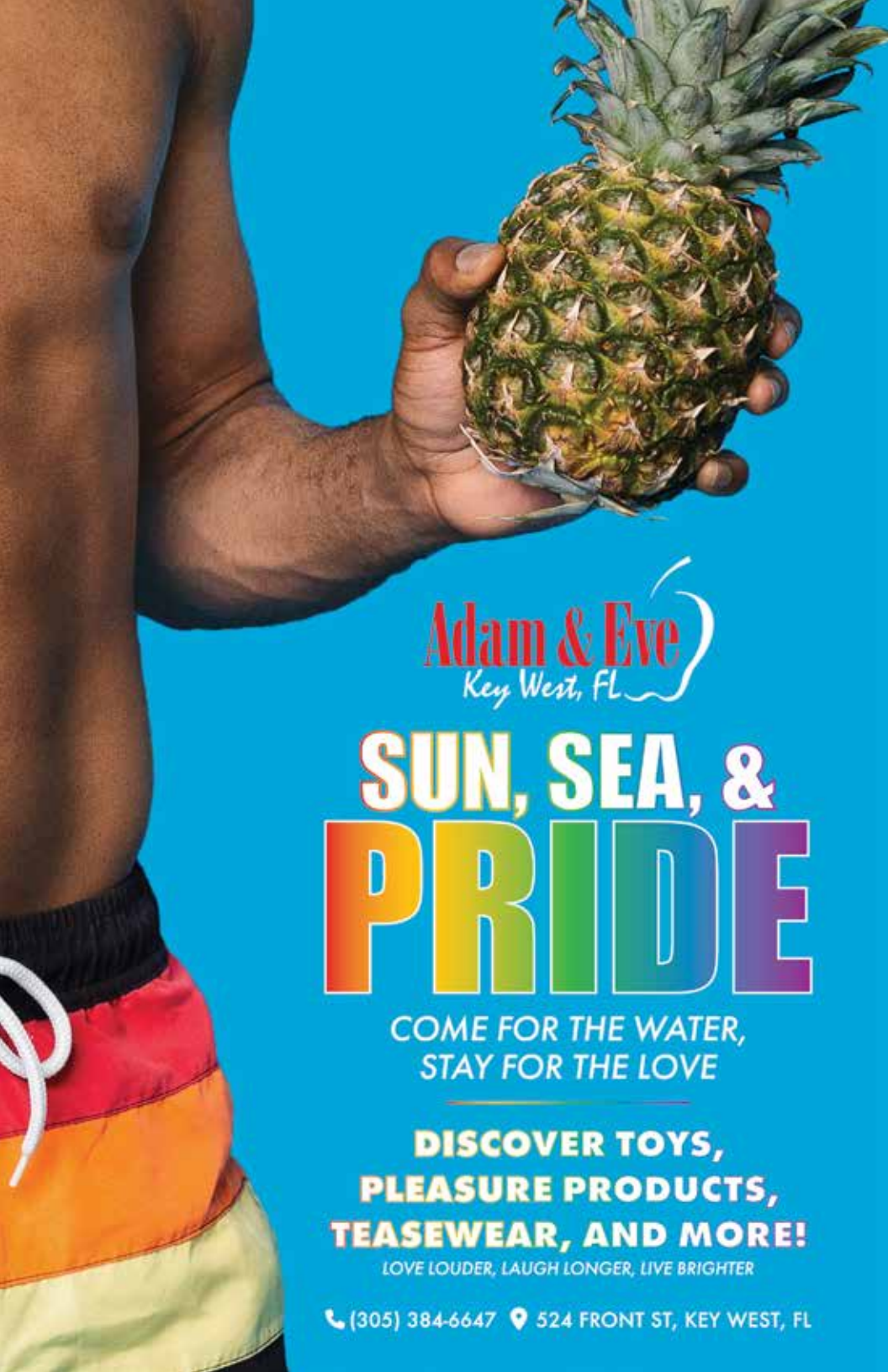

Dear Nana,

I'm not feeling much like pride this year. I usually love to go to a few prides around the country and really celebrate. But everything in the news and in the world is just really getting to me lately. I'm trying to pump myself up and not let the world in, but it isn't working. Do you have any advice on how to get yourself out of a funk?

I understand, kiddo. It's hard to feel like Rainbow Brite when the country (and the world) seem to be going to hell in a knock-off handbag. First, I would remind you that Pride didn't start as a party. It started as a riot. And in better times, we should celebrate and recharge our batteries.
